

Canna Lilies



Canna lilies are fantastic tropical plants from Central and South America. Their colourful and luxuriant foliage is topped with equally colourful flowers. Although they have tropical origins Cannas are very vigorous and easy to grow in the UK and if a few guidelines are followed, will flower reliably each year.

- ✓ Grow in fertile soil either in pots or in the ground.
- ✓ Water regularly and feed every couple of weeks with a proprietary fertiliser when in active growth.

If growing in a conservatory or heated greenhouse plants will remain evergreen throughout the year and can even flower all year round.

During mild winters large clumps of Cannas can survive outside, however they should be treated as tender plants.

After the first frosts all the foliage should be cut down. Lift the rhizomes and store them in frost-free conditions in the same way as Dahlia tubers.
